# "Firefighting - Dealing with Conflict"

- 1. Unresolved Conflicts in our relationships can become raging fires.
  - A Smolder A slow burning fire in an unseen place.
  - Soot Can release toxic fumes when certain things are burned.
  - Flashpoints In the search for more oxygen, explosions can occur, resulting in more damage and spreading fires

### 2. A good conflict can move you forward.
